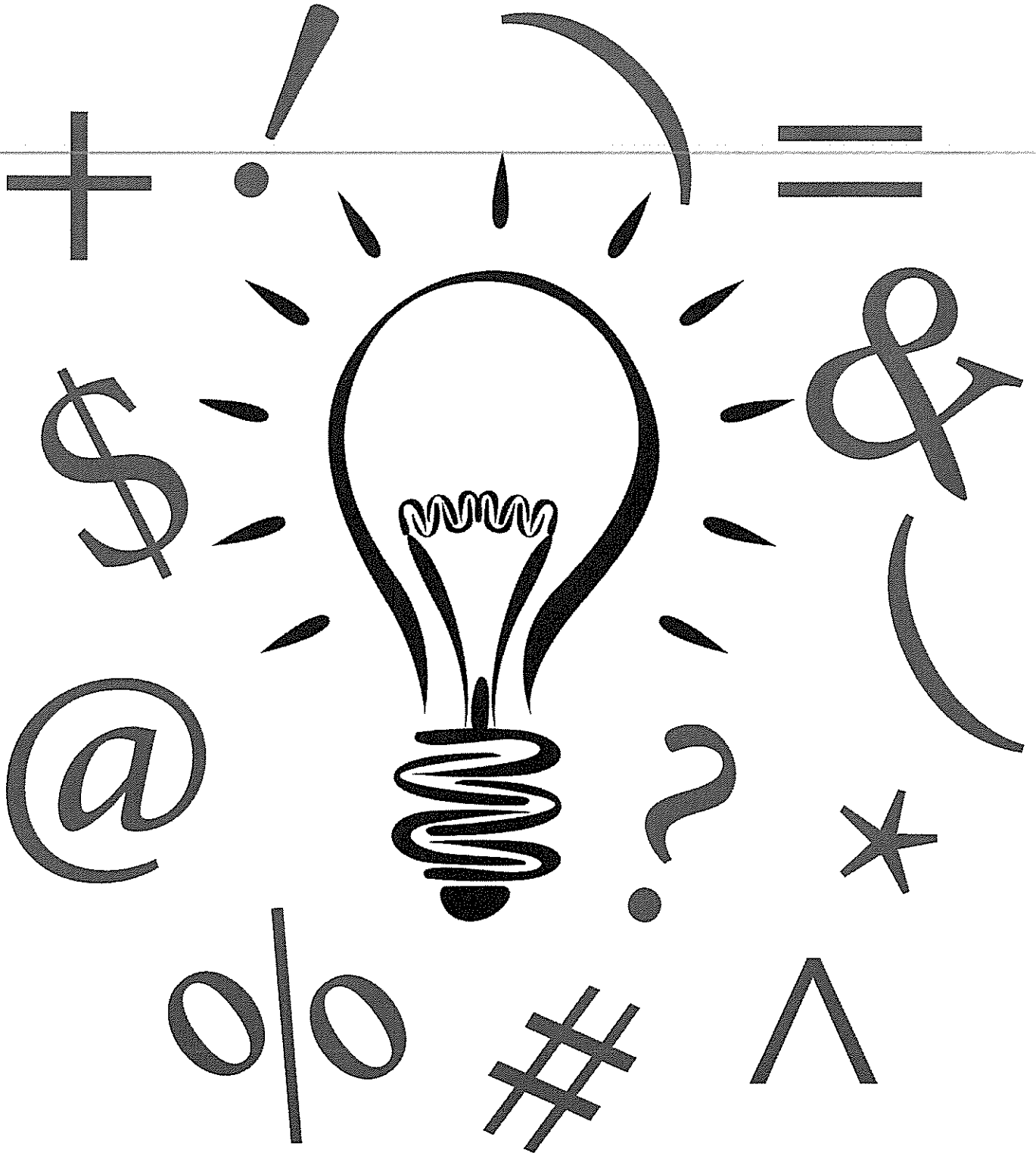

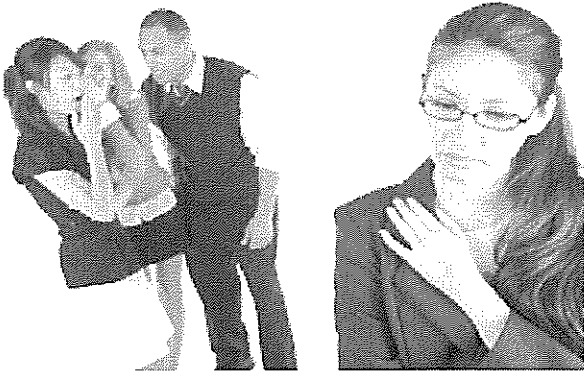

As a person in a leadership position, if you observe any of these types of actions depicted in the images below from your team members, what types of action, if any, can you take with your selected leadership style?









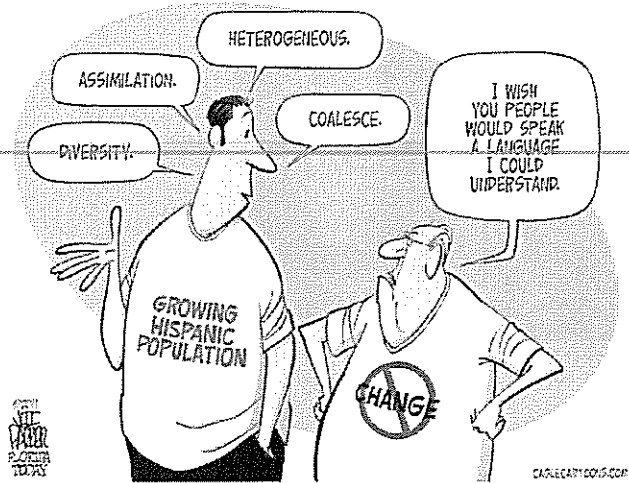




LEADERSHIP QUESTION

2. What actions were taking with your selected leadership style?

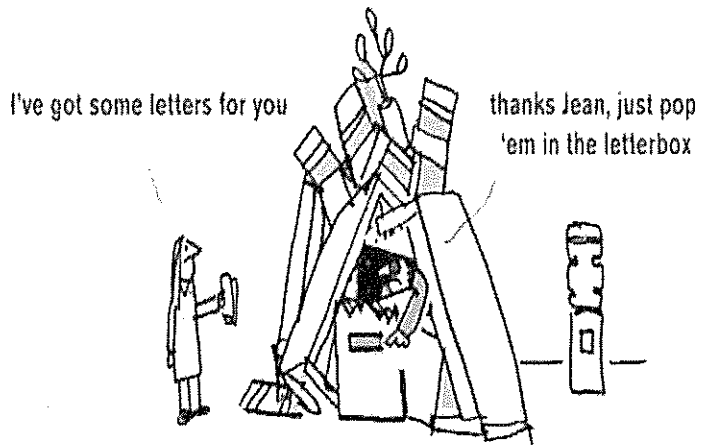


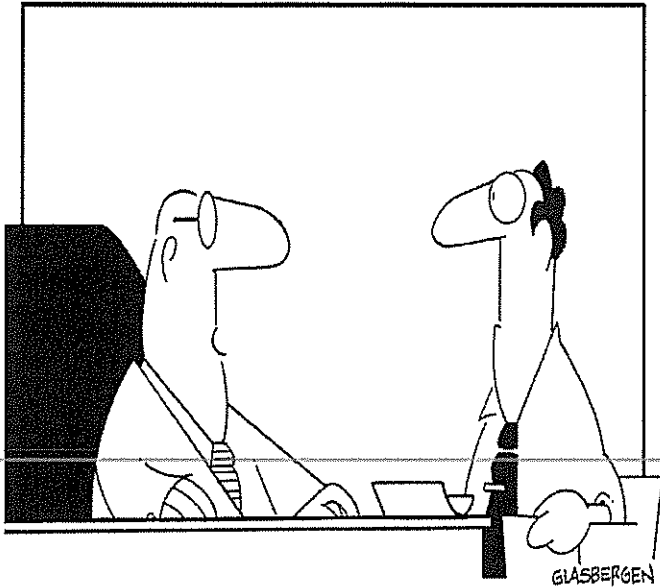
